

# Representing relief using LAYER COLOURING

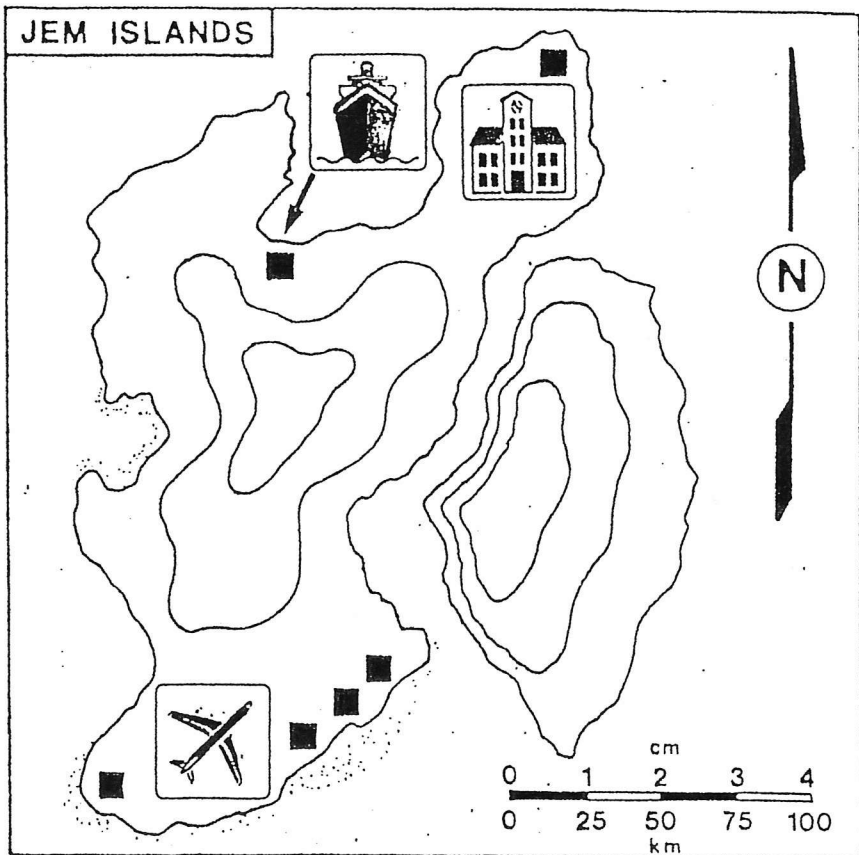
Most ATLAS MAPS use layer colouring to show relief.

The most accepted colour scheme is ;

**LEGEND**

	WATER.....	blue
	LOWLAND.....	green
	MIDDLELAND.....	yellow
	HIGHLAND.....	brown

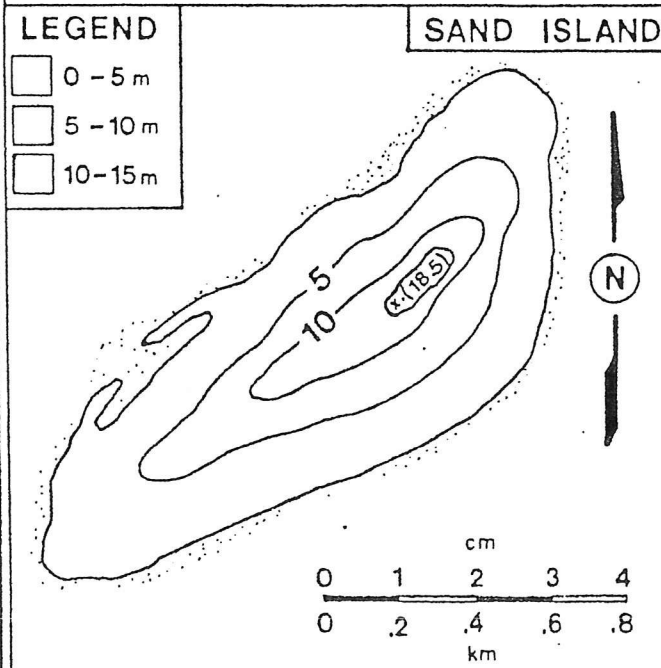
① Layer colour the JEM ISLANDS using the above legend.



② Layer colour SAND ISLAND. The highest elevation is 18.5 m.

Therefore the entire island is considered a 'LOWLAND'.

Using 3 shades of green, complete the island.



③ Layer colour MOUNTAIN PEAKS. The lowest elevation is 1935 m.

Therefore the peaks are to be considered 'HIGHLANDS'.

Using 3 shades of brown, complete the peaks.
