

Urban Land Use

- ⇒ Almost 80% of Canadians live, work, travel, shop and spend leisure time in cities
- ⇒ To meet these needs a city must have factories, offices, houses, apartments, roads, rail lines, stores, parks, cemeteries, schools, etc.
- ⇒ All these above features fall into one of six major land-use groups:
 - 40% Residential
 - 32% Transportation
 - 5% Commercial
 - 6% Industrial
 - 7% Recreational / Open Space
 - 10% Institutional / Public Buildings
